The first annual conference will coincide with the founding of the Society. It invites all discussions of anthropological, cultural, economic, ethical, historical, philosophical, political, and sociological aspects of nanosciences and emerging technologies.

The program committee welcomes individual abstracts, proposals for panels with three to five presentations, as well as roundtable or workshop discussions. Graduate students are invited to submit. Submit 250-word abstracts for individual papers, 1200-word-abstracts for entire panels, 500-word descriptions of workshop discussions by February 15 online at <http://theSNET.net>. Notifications of acceptance will be mailed by April 15. See the conference website <http://theSNET.net> for keynote speakers, accommodations, other updates. – US graduate students in all areas of nanotechnology and its study may be eligible for travel support through the University of Washington Center for Workforce Development.
